

NO-SORT RECYCLING

Recycling is collected every-other week. Check the decal inside the lid of your recycling cart. If it's **purple** you recycle on purple colored weeks, if it's **orange** you recycle on orange colored weeks. Refer to the decal for a list of what can and cannot be recycled.

THANK YOU FOR RECYCLING!

Since the Curb It program began, Boise City residents increased the recycling rate by 50%! Follow these helpful tips to keep our recycling rates high.

PLEASE **DO NOT** PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR BLUE RECYCLING CART:

- NO **GLASS** (take glass to drop off locations listed on www.curbitboise.org)
- NO **PLASTIC FILM BAGS** – white grocery bags, food bags, etc (white grocery bags can be returned to most grocery and retail stores)
- NO **STYROFOAM**
- NO **YARD WASTE**
- NO **TRASH**

If these items are found in the cart, recycling will not be collected, and residents will have to remove the material by hand.

HERE ARE SOME OTHER HELPFUL RECYCLING TIPS:

- Flatten, cut or breakdown cardboard to fit inside your blue carts
- If all your recycling materials won't fit in your blue cart, you can either:
 - ♦ Place it in your old recycling bin, open box, or clean trash can and set next to your blue cart with a handwritten sign that says "items for recycling"
 - ♦ Or if you consistently have extra recycling, please call Allied Waste at **345-1266** to order another blue recycling cart for free

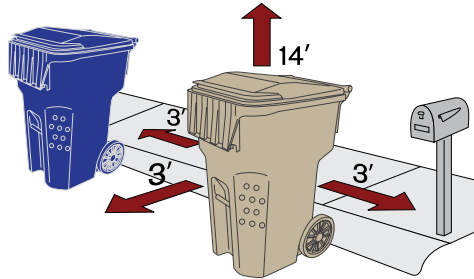


2010 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Trash and recycling collection are delayed by one day for: **New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.** Holidays are noted in red on the recycling calendar on back.

TRASH COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Set carts out by 7 a.m. Remove from street within 24 hours.
- Keep carts at least **3 feet** away from other carts, mail boxes, fire hydrants, parked cars and utility poles, and **14 feet** away from overhead tree branches. Place cart in the street, against the curb with the handle facing towards residence.
- **Appliances or large items?** Call **345-1266** to arrange free pick-up.
- **Tree branches** must fit inside the trash cart or be tied into bundles 4 feet or less in length and less than 60 lbs. Attach overflow trash sticker to bundles and set next to trash cart.
- **Do NOT put liquids or hazardous wastes in trash.**
- **Used motor oil** must be placed in a transparent, two-gallon or smaller container for collection. The container will NOT be returned. Set the used oil container near the trash or recycling cart. **Do NOT put the motor oil into the carts.**
- **Damaged or broken cart?** Call **345-1266** to report damage and receive a free replacement cart.
- **Special services:** Carry-out, service for those with disabilities, and low-income discounts are available. Call **384-3735** for more information.



2010 SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

RESIDENTIAL CLEANUP WEEKS: **April 26-30 and December 27-31**

Boise City offers these two weeks of free overflow trash collection service. Residents can dispose of larger amounts of trash generated during spring cleanup and the holiday season. Set out as much trash as you want, but it all needs to be set out in 20- to 32-gallon trash cans or wheeled carts. No overflow stickers are needed.

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION: **November 1 - December 3**

Set your leaves out in **compostable paper bags** by 7 a.m. on your trash day. Separate leaf bags from trash carts by 3 feet or more. **Leaves in plastic bags will not be collected.** A \$10 coupon for compostable leaf bags is mailed to each household in October.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION: **December 27 - January 7, 2011**

Remove ALL decorations and tree stand. Set Christmas tree and branches out several feet from trash on your regular pick-up day. Cut into 4-foot lengths and bundle. Flocked & tinsel trees & wreaths cannot be recycled.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION SITES

The city has daily neighborhood collection sites open from noon-7 p.m. Waste must be dropped off when the collection vehicle is present. Household hazardous waste includes paints, stains, varnish, fluorescent light tubes, TV's, computer monitors, batteries, pesticides and herbicides.
